


Instruction Compass

How to use the compass

Hold it horizontally and look at the compass. The red arrow points at the wind direction, which you can see under the arrow. (North, East, South and West) The red arrow is illuminated by 3 betalights for navigation at night.

For very precise navigation in degrees, you have to hold the compass horizontally in front of your eye. Look in the upstanding mirror at the end of the arrow. Here you can see the wind-direction in degrees. The mirror is illuminated with one betalight for navigation at night.



NO BATTERIES

The compass needs no power supply of any sort. Illumination is provided by the Betalight- a borosilicate glass capsule, internally phosphor-coated, and filled with tritium gas, which activates the phosphor to emit light.

LONG LIFE

The compass has an in-service life of over ten years, with no need for any maintenance, and is designed to survive in the harshest climatic conditions. It conforms to MoD Defence Standard 62-4

ROBUST & SECURE

The compact and robust green rubber housing protects the sturdy glass lens and scale panel from scratching or breakage.

The warranty on this compass is 5 years
